My husband and I are senior citizens and live on a very tight budget. Our only income is from Social Security (which haven't had a raise in 2 yrs) and a small pension check we get from a former employer which we haven't had any raises on in several years.

In the meantime everything else keeps going up such as what I call "daily living expenses" gas, food, gas & etc.

How are we who are in low income suppose to pay these bills when they keep getting raises every few months? I've always been taught that when more is going out than coming in you're in Big Trouble. What's going to happen when people can't afford to pay for those services?
