RE: Informal Conference of November 29, 2011

Pursuant to a Notice of Informal Conference issued November 21, 2011, an Informal Conference was conducted at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky on November 29, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. A list of attendees is attached. Mr. Moore, the complainant, did not attend the conference, did not participate by telephone, and has not contacted Commission Staff since the conference regarding his inability to attend.

Staff indicated that the purpose of the Informal Conference was to determine whether any attempts at settlement had occurred. Duke Energy indicated that no attempts had been made.

Staff then asked a number of questions concerning the number of meter bases located at Complainant's property, and whether any other meter bases were defective. Duke Kentucky indicated that it would attempt to contact Complainant for the purpose of checking the additional meter bases at Complainant's property and report back to Commission staff as to the results of those efforts.¹

There being no additional matters to discuss, the conference was adjourned.

¹ On November 30, 2011, counsel for Duke, Mr. D'Ascenzo, spoke with Mr. John Shupp of Commission Staff and informed him of a telephone conversation with Complainant and indicated that Mr. Moore would not agree to allow Duke to check the meter bases at the Center Street property without some communication from the Commission.
