MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND CONTINUATION OF HEARING DATE


Johnson County Gas Company, Inc. (“Johnson County”) and Bud Rife (“Rife”), by counsel, hereby move the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the “Commission”): (1) for an extension of time to respond to the Commission’s June 10, 2011 Order (“Order”); and (2) to continue the show cause hearing scheduled for July 6, 2011.

In support of their motion, Johnson County and Rife state that they have retained counsel to assist them with regard to this matter and to assist Johnson County on a going-forward basis with filings at the Commission. Counsel, having just been retained, has not had an opportunity to thoroughly investigate the factual and legal issues raised by the Commission’s Order, particularly with regard to the *prima facie* showings stated in the Order. Therefore, an extension of time and continuation of the hearing date would be helpful for counsel to assist Johnson County and Rife in fully and completely responding to the Commission’s Order.

As further grounds for their motion for an extension of time and continuation of the hearing date, Johnson County and Rife state that an extension of time would permit them and the Commission to explore the possibility of resolving the issues raised by the Commission in its Order through settlement negotiations, thereby possibly dispensing with the need to hold a show cause hearing.

Accordingly, Johnson County and Rife respectfully request that the Commission grant them a four week extension to respond to the Commission's June 10, 2011 Order in this matter; and continue the hearing date for four weeks, to be scheduled at a time convenient for the Commission, so that Johnson County and Rife might explore with the Commission the possibility of resolving this matter through negotiations and without requiring a show cause hearing.
