The show of flexibility comes in advance of Thursday's meeting between Obama and top congressional leaders to raise the debt limit and avoid a historic default. White House spokesman Jay Carney said Wednesday that Obama is confident he has enough lawmakers behind him to reduce the debt by more than \$2 trillion over the next 10 years.

Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.
