INTRA-AGENCY MEMORANDUM

Pursuant to the Commission's Order of December 2, 2012, a telephone conference call was held in this case On January 8, 2013. Participating in the conference call were:

Robert Moore - Forest Creek, LLC
Bruce Smith - Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District
Gerald Wuetcher - Commission Staff

Mr. Moore and Mr. Smith advised that the parties were still in negotiations and required an additional 60 days in which to complete those negotiations. They recommended that the Commission continue this matter for an additional 60 days and that another status conference call be conducted March 8, 2013. They further requested that Commission Staff provide some guidance on past Commission interpretations of 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11(3). More specifically, the parties desired guidance on the costs related to a water main extension that are subject to refund. The participants agreed that a conference call on this issue would be arranged for January 15, 2013.

The conference call then concluded.
