**RE:** Conference Call of May 10, 2013

On May 10, 2013, Commission Staff conducted a conference call in this matter to discuss the current status of negotiations between the parties. This call was originally scheduled to be conducted on May 8, 2013, but was rescheduled on the morning of May 8, 2013 at the request of counsel for Forest Creek LLC. Participating in the conference call were:

Beginning the conference call, Mr. Wuetcher also stated that Commission Staff would prepare minutes of the conference for the case record, that a copy of the minutes would be provided to all parties, and that all parties would be given an opportunity to submit written comments upon those minutes.

Mr. Moore and Mr. Smith discussed the status of negotiations between the parties. Mr. Moore indicated that an additional 30 days was to complete negotiations. They indicated that, if the parties were unable to reach a resolution within that period, the matter should be scheduled for hearing. The conference attendees agreed that a conference call should be scheduled for June 7, 2013.
