**INTRA-AGENCY MEMORANDUM**  
**KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION**

**RE:** Informal Conference of March 6, 2012

Pursuant to a Notice of Informal Conference issued February 16, 2012, an Informal Conference ("IC") in this case was held at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky on March 6, 2012. A list of attendees is attached.

This matter arises from a complaint filed by William Allen Roberts against Taylor County RECC requesting that electric utility service be provided to his property located at 728 Lether Burton Road, Columbia, Adair County, Kentucky.

Mr. Roberts indicated that he contacted Taylor County RECC ("Taylor County") in 2010 to request that it extend electric utility service to his property. Taylor County sent a staking engineer to Mr. Roberts' property to determine the best route available to run electric distribution lines. Although Taylor County identified three feasible alternative distribution routes, each of these paths required obtaining an easement from one or more landowners near Mr. Roberts' Lether Burton Road property.

Both Mr. Roberts and Taylor County have been unsuccessful in obtaining the necessary easement(s) in order for Taylor County to provide electric utility service to Mr. Roberts' Lether Burton Road property.

Mr. Roberts stated that his primary concern was to get electric service as quickly and as inexpensively as possible. The parties indicated a willingness to discuss the matter further. Taylor County will file a status report on the outcome of those discussions with the Commission by April 17, 2012.

There being no further matters to discuss, the IC was adjourned.
