Gas Prices Fallen 9.2¢

Average retail gasoline prices in Kentucky have fallen 9.2 cents per gallon in the past week, averaging \$3.38/g yesterday. This compares with the national average that has fallen 7.1 cents per gallon in the last week to \$3.53/g, according to gasoline price website KentuckyGasPrices.com.

Including the change in gas prices in Kentucky during the past week, prices yesterday were 75.7 cents per gallon higher than the same day one year ago and are 22.4 cents per gallon lower than a month ago. The national average has decreased 7.2 cents per gallon during the last month and stands 82.9 cents per gallon higher than this day one year ago.

"Last week saw an impressive decline in crude oil and gasoline futures, and accordingly, motorists in most areas of the U.S. have seen retail gasoline prices decline. In some areas, price have outright plunged to under \$3/gal," said Patrick DeHaan, GasBuddy.com Senior Petroleum Analyst. "While so-
