ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation and approval of its regional meetings to be held in Morehead, Owensboro, and Draffenville, Kentucky in October 2011. These meetings involve presentations on non-revenue water and the installation, maintenance, and testing of water meter equipment.

This Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties."¹ Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the presentations in question will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for 2.0 hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

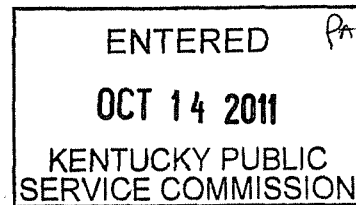
1. KRWA's regional meeting in Morehead, Kentucky on October 18, 2011 is accredited and approved for a maximum of two credit hours of water district management training.


2. KRWA's regional meeting in Owensboro, Kentucky on October 20, 2011 is accredited and approved for a maximum of two credit hours of water district management training.
