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

MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSES TO COMMISSION
STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION AND KENTUCKY POWER
COMPANY'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION**

Intervenors Tom Vierheller, Beverly May, and Sierra Club (collectively "Environmental Intervenors") request an extension of time to file responses to Commission Staff's First Request for Information and Objections and Responses to Kentucky Power Company's First Request for Information. Under the August 5, 2001 Orders, Environmental Intervenors responses to requests for information were due by April 2, 2012. Environmental Intervenors local counsel is out of town this week so they are using a copy service in Frankfort, Kentucky to handle this filing. On Friday, March 30 Environmental Intervenors sent to the copy service via Federal Express a compact disc with all of the attachments to both the Commission Staff's and Kentucky Power Company's requests, which the copy company received on the morning of April 2, 2012. On the

morning of April 2, 2012, the Environmental Intervenors emailed the Responses to Commission Staff's First Request for Information and Objections and Responses to Kentucky Power Company's First Request for Information to the copy service. Unfortunately, the copy company was unable to print all the requisite copies and deliver them to the Commission by the listed deadline. Environmental Intervenors request a one-time extension of time to file Commission Staff's First Request for Information and Objections and Responses to Kentucky Power Company's First Request for Information by Tuesday, April 3, 2012. Environmental Intervenors commit to making sure that such error will not happen again in these dockets.

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
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
