



This matter has been brought before the Bullitt County Judge Executive upon application of the Hardin County Water District No. 1 to expand its boundaries.

1. Written requests have been submitted by two freeholders in Bullitt County, Kentucky,
2. Notice of the Petition has been published in The Pioneer News on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2012;
3. The Judge Executive, having considered the request and conducted a public hearing, finds said request to be reasonable, and hereby approves the extension of the boundaries of the Hardin County Water District No. 1 in order to facilitate the acquisition and operation of water production and treatment facilities located within the boundaries of the Fort Knox Military Installation. Henceforth, the boundaries of the Hardin County Water District No. 1 shall extend into and encompass all of that portion of Bullitt County, Kentucky, which lies within the For Knox Military Installation and is more specifically described in attached Exhibit 2.

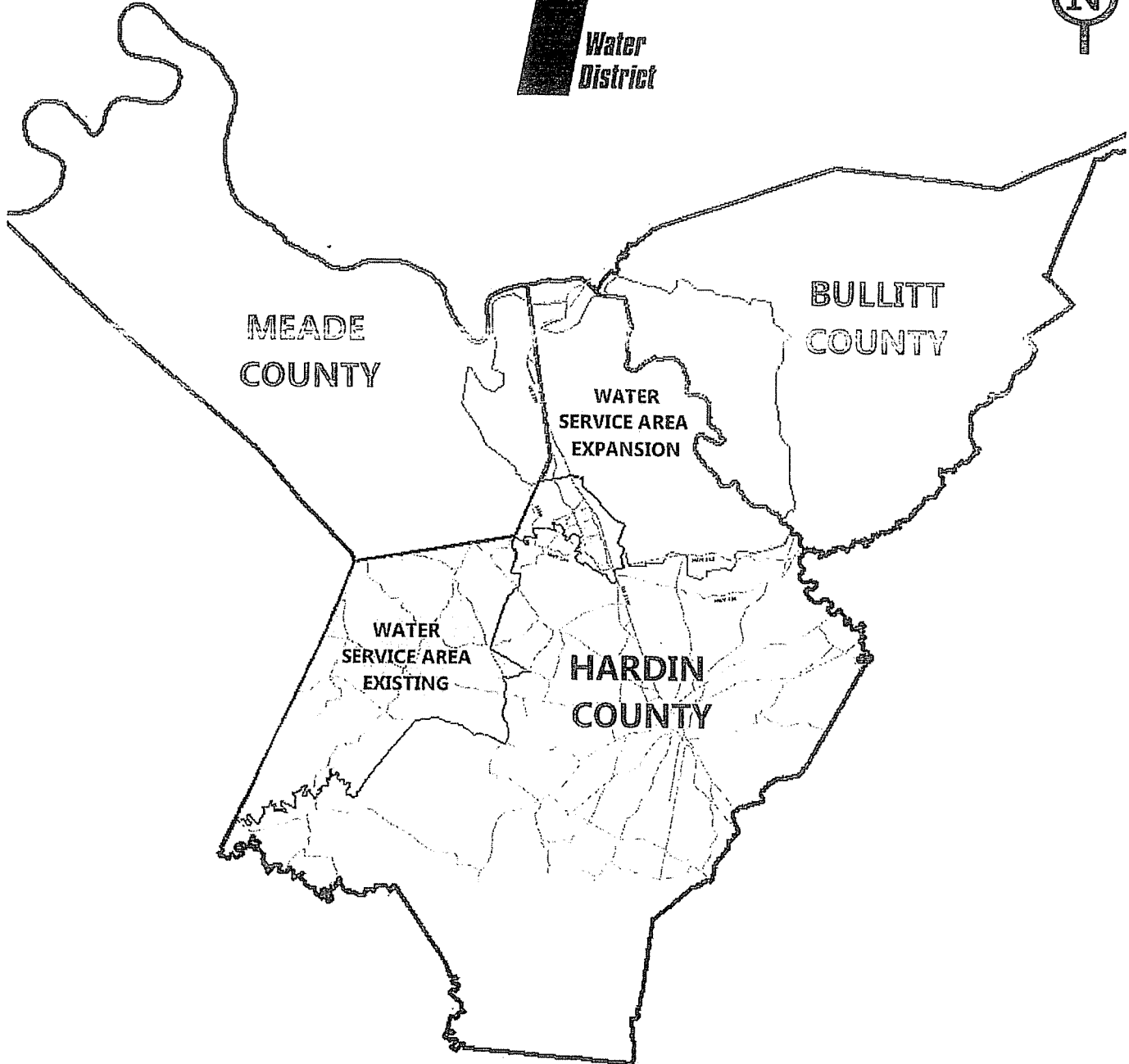

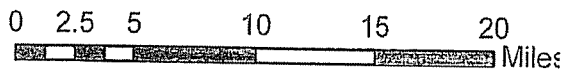
