The Applicant, Simpson County Water District (the "District"), files this Application pursuant to KRS 278.300, 807 KAR 5:001, and all other applicable laws and regulations, and requests that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the "Commission") enter an Order authorizing the District to issue certain securities in the approximate principal sum of \$1,565,000 (subject to adjustment of up to 10%), for the purpose of refunding certain outstanding water system revenue bonds of the District.
