Our board passed a resolution adopting new rates to be effective November 10, 2011.


I enclose the following:




**NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS OF  
SOUTHERN MADISON WATER DISTRICT**

Due to a rate increase from Berea Municipal Utilities, notice is hereby given that Southern Madison Water District will file an application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its water rates as reflected below. Customer rates will increase by \$0.40 per 1,000 gallons of water used. The proposed change will be effective November 10, 2011.

Monthly Water Rates
