I am the attorney for the Southern Madison Water District in southern Madison County, Kentucky. The Berea Municipal Utilities, from whom we purchase our water, has recently raised the wholesale water rate they charge our District. Our board passed a resolution adopting new rates to be effective November 10, 2011.
