Mr. Jones:

We wish to notify you that the Kentucky Public Service Commission granted an order in connection with our Rate Case 2010-00094 in which we were granted an increase that affects the rate you pay for wholesale water purchased from our system. As previously discussed in our letter to you on January 21, 2011, effective January 1, 2012, the wholesale rate will go from the current rate of \$3.05 per 1,000 gallons (\$2.28 per 100 cubic feet) to \$3.13 per 1,000 gallons (\$2.34 per 100 cubic feet). This is the second and final phase of a two step process that was associated with Rate Case 2010-00094.


