The Commission Staff has reviewed Taylor County R.E.C.C.'s application in the above case. This filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below.

Filing deficiencies pursuant to:

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(7)(d):

Operating budget for each month of the period encompassing the pro forma adjustments. The operating budget provided is for the year ending August 2011 rather than the test year of November 2011.

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(7)(e):


Number of customers to be added to the test period – end level of customers and the related revenue requirements impact for all pro forma adjustments with complete details and supporting work papers. The schedule for number of customers is as of August 2011 rather than the test year of November 2011.

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(4):

If copy of public notice included, did it meet requirements? The public notice failed to show that the "After Hours" charge related to the "Service Investigation" and "Termination/Field Collection" charges is currently \$35 and is proposed to increase to \$90.

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned information is filed with the Commission. If your filing contains a proposed effective date, the rejection of your filing for reasons of deficiencies voids that proposed effective date. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies, you may re-file your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is a least 30 days from the date you file the required information.
