

MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE


Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers (“KIUC”) moves the Commission to amend the Procedural Schedule to permit the filing of intervenor testimony or comments.

On March 28, 2012, Big Rivers Electric Corporation filed the Application in this matter seeking the Commission’s approval for the issuance of certain new evidences of indebtedness. On April 4, 2012, the Commission issued an Order setting out a procedural schedule. Although the Order permits two rounds of discovery and contemplates that intervenors will have the opportunity to file testimony (see Order, Paragraph 4), the Order does not establish a date for the filing of intervenor testimony.

Big Rivers’ responses to KIUC’s supplemental requests for information are due by May 11, 2012. KIUC will expeditiously review the responses and can promptly file testimony or comments by May 18, 2012. It is KIUC’s present intention to file written comments in lieu of testimony.

Therefore, KIUC moves to amend the procedural schedule in order to allow intervenors to file testimony or comments no later than May 18, 2012.
