Dear Mr. Derouen:

Enclosed please find an original and six (6) copies of a proposed new tariff to be utilized in conjunction with Owen Electric Cooperative's (Owen) Smart Home Pilot Project.

Owen communicated with the Commission in Case No 2011-00037 that it planned to roll out a Smart Home pilot in 2012. That pilot project has now been developed and Owen believes that a new tariff is necessary for this program.

The proposed tariff is different from the TOD rates recently approved by the Commission in Case No 2011-00037 in that the recently approved rates follow more closely the TOD rates charged to Owen by its wholesale power supplier, East Kentucky Power Corp. The proposed pilot tariff has a much shorter on-peak time, and expanded off-peak and shoulder times which Owen believes will be more member friendly and will incent members to participate in the pilot program.

Owen plans to offer this rate only to pilot participants at this time and will file a permanent tariff with the Commission at a later date, if the desire is to offer the program and tariff beyond the pilot program.

- F. Terms of Payment – the above rates are net, the gross being five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within fifteen days from the date the bill was rendered, the prompt payment discount will be forfeited and the gross amount shall apply.

The monthly kilowatt hour usage shall be subject to plus or minus an adjustment per kWh determined in accordance with the Fuel Adjustment Clause.

The tariff is subject to the Energy Emergency Control Program as filed with the Kentucky Energy Regulatory Commission (now the Public Service Commission) on February 23, 1981, in Administrative Case No. 240, and as approved by the Commission Order of March 31, 1981.
