Sir:

On 1-29-13 I spoke with Ginny Smith of the PSC to register a formal complaint about our electricity. A few days later she called to say that I should put my complaint in writing. The following relates to Case # 2012-00312.

For much of Dec., Jan., and Feb. our lights have flickered dimmed and strobed as bad as they ever have over the passed two years. The new line made by PSC installed over a year ago to address the problem has done little, if anything, to diminish the intensity of this phenomenon. At best, it's reduced the duration of the events. To be honest, it is difficult to recall exactly what it was like prior to the new line... the flickering was, and still is, obnoxious, distracting and wrong. It has never ceased... when the quarry crushes stone our power is negatively impacted.

Two weeks ago I found it difficult to read due

to the fluctuation in the intensity of the light. As of late, these events have expanded to occur Fridays and many Saturdays.

I continue to feel slighted by the fact that the quarry upgraded its equipment and the quality of our electricity has been reduced. I have little doubt that this would be tolerated in Brandenburg. I am frustrated that Hilltop Quarry has yet another way to diminish our quality of life.

I increasingly feel that the PSC's lack of action towards a fair and adequate resolution is the solution that the attorneys, the RECC & the quarry seek. Is this what the PSC wants as well?

Over a year ago we were given a list of dates and for a hearing and asked which ones would be suitable. We responded and that was the last heard on that topic.

We still have a supply of electricity that is inferior to what it was prior to the upgrade at the quarry over two years ago.
