The Commission Staff received, on January 8, 2013, Grayson R.E.C.C.'s . response letter to the deficiencies for the application filed on December 27, 2012. This filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below.

Filing deficiencies pursuant to:

## 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(4):

(1) Copy of public notice did not meet requirements

## 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(a):

(1) Amount of change requested in dollar amounts and percentage for each customer classification to which change will apply.

807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(3)(c):

(1) Electric, gas, water and sewer utilities – effect upon average bill for each customer class to which change will apply

## 807 KAR 5:001, Section 10(1)(b)(7):

- (1) The proposed tariff for Schedule 2 shows an energy charge per kWh rate of \$.10679 and the notice shows a charge of \$.106789859 while the billing analysis supports a rate of \$.10689.
- (2) The proposed tariff for Schedule 16 shows an energy charge per kWh rate of \$4.6558 while the comparative tariff shows a rate of \$0.6558. The Notice contains a rate of \$.06558.
- (3) There is no tariff for the proposed prepay metering program in either Exhibit B or H.
