## ORDER

Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the presentations in question will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for 2.0 hours of water district management training.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's regional meeting in Morehead, Kentucky on October 16, 2012 is accredited and approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours of water district management training.

- 2. KRWA's regional meeting in Owensboro, Kentucky on October 18, 2012 is accredited and approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours of water district management training.
- 3. KRWA's regional meeting in Draffenville, Kentucky on October 25, 2012 is accredited and approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours of water district management training.
- 4. KRWA shall retain a record of all water district commissioners attending the accredited and approved presentation.
  - 5. No later than December 1, 2012, KRWA shall file with the Commission:
- a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed;
- b. A description of any changes in the presenters or the proposed curriculum that occurred after KRWA's application; and
- c. The name of each attending water district commissioner, his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended.
