If that is the case, then combining the two proposed debt service schedules would make sense. It would make more sense, however, if only one debt service schedule is provided.

Notwithstanding the one or two schedule, Commission Staff cannot confirm the savings calculations without the present debt service payment schedule for Series 2003A.

- Confirmation that the proposed debt service schedule submitted on 2/18/2013 (\$1,945,000) is for Series 2003A only (or in the alternative confirmation that it represents combined debt service)
- Confirmation that the submitted proposed debt schedules for Warren District should combined to determine the new debt service for Series 2003A and 2003C under the Supplement Agreement or, in the alternative, confirmation that the calculation of savings should be performed separately.

Jerry,

Randy passed along your email regarding Warren County Water District so that I could respond to your questions. I've attached the original amortization schedules as well as the final financial schedules that reflect the rates and numbers as a result of the bond sale on 2/14. The water district (actually, all borrowers in this refunding) made their 2/1/13 principal and interest payments (in this case \$85,000 for 2003 A and \$19,700 for 2003 C). That leaves \$1,730,000 in principal outstanding for 2003 A and \$317,800 for 2003 C. However, while the 2003 C issue was borrowed by Warren County Water District, the payments come in part from the City of Bowling Green and in part from a Development Authority (Series 2003 C refunded a USDA-RD bond issue - I don't recall what project the original USDA-RD bond issue was for that the City and Development Authority worked together on). The City of Bowling Green has chosen to pay their portion off in cash, and the Development Authority has chosen to refund their portion, which is why you don't see the full amount of principal that will defease the issue in the schedules (if I included the City's portion in the schedules it would skew the savings schedule, since the part that is being paid off with cash is not technically savings as a result of the refunding).

In confirmation – the \$1,975,000 does represent all of 2003 A and the part of 2003 C that is being refunded. Both the 2003 A and 2003 C loans will be fully defeased upon closing.
