Dear Ms. Faulkner,

We received notice dated 3-July that our rate case application for the above case had been rejected for filing deficiencies. Specifically, that our proposed tariff sheets for rate changes was not submitted with the application.

We are herein submitting the proposed tariff sheet. This new proposed sheet (5-42) replaces in entirety four existing sheets; $5-42 \sim 5-45$. In the application and approval to acquire the Radcliff System (Case 2008-00074), the District requested to adopt the City of Radcliff's existing Sewer Use Ordinance as its initial tariff document (See tariff sheet 5-1, approved by Commission 4/20/2008).

Our application requests to change the sanitary charges only. The existing high strength charges are not being proposed to change, but are included on the proposed tariff sheet. As much of the City ordinance language is not required or no longer applies, we have shortened and removed much of this extraneous language. We have included 10 copies of the existing sheets being replaced.

The balance of our Radcliff Sewer tariff is not changing nor is proposed to change at this time. We have enclosed 10 copies of the proposed tariff sheet per your requirement. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call.

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ARTICLE XI. SEWER SERVICE CHARGES

1. Sewer Service Charges: Sewer service charges shall be levied on all users with a consumptive use of water who discharge, cause or permit the discharge of sewage into the public wastewater treatment system. Prior to any use of the wastewater system all persons or corporations are required to apply for and open a sewer customer account in accordance with procedures and rules set forth in Sheets1 through 5 of the District's water tariff. The following schedule of rates shall apply to each user of the wastewater treatment system: but does not include other applicable charges and non-recurring fees set forth within the sewer or water tariff;

Charge	Rate	Units Charged
Minimum Bill	\$19.86	Per month for up to 2,000 gallons of water consumption
Volume Charge - 1,000 to 2,000 gallons water consumption	\$6.48	Per 1,000 gallons of water
Volume Charge - above 2,000 gallons water consumption	\$5.84	Per 1,000 gallons of water
Volume Charge - Wholesale Treatment only	\$3.04	Per 1,000 gallons (based on measurement method in the Wholesale User Agreement)

- 2. Surcharges for Excessive Strength: Customers which qualify for a special discharge permit, as provided for in Article V of this tariff, may be subject to additional high strength surcharges for those amounts for BOD (Biological Oxygen Demand), TSS (Total Suspended Solids) and Ammonia Nitrogen. These rates are charged on the difference between the user's pollutant concentration (mg/l) and the allowable concentration for normal wastewater (mg/l)multiplied by the surcharge rate, weight of one gallon of water (8.34lbs.) and the user's monthly flow measured to the wastewater system. These surcharge amounts are:
 - Thirty-two cents (\$0.32) per pound of excessive biochemical oxygen demand a.
 - Twenty-two cents (\$0.22) per pound of excessive suspended solids b.
 - Ninety-five cents (\$0.95) per pound of excessive ammonia nitrogen C.

ARTICLE XI. SEWER SERVICE CHARGES ORDINANCE NO. 96-03-705, AMENDMENT 96-06-711 Sec. 17-31. Sewer service charges.

- (a) Sewer service charges shall be charges levied on all users with a consumptive use of water who discharge, cause or permit the discharge of sewage into the public wastewater treatment system. (Ord. of 6-22-96)
- (b) Sewer service charges shall be comprised of a system of user charges, excessive strength or toxicity surcharges and a system of charges for debt service.
- (c) User charges shall mean charges levied on users of the wastewater system to offset the cost of operation and maintenance of the system.
- (d) Excessive strength or toxicity surcharges shall mean charges levied on users of the wastewater treatment system whose contribution contains pollutants (both conventional and toxic) in concentrations which exceeded limits specified by latest Radcliff, Kentucky Sewer Use Ordinance for such pollutants.
- (e) Charges for debt service shall mean charges levied on users of the wastewater treatment system to support the annual debt service or obligations of the system (Ord. of 6-16-87, 1; Ord. of 3-25-96)

 Editor's note-Ord. of June 16, 1987, 1-4, not expressly amendatory of the Gode, has been included herein as Art. III, 17-31 17-34, at the discretion of the editor:

Sec. 17-32. Sewer rates.

- (a) The following schedule of rates shall apply to each user of the wastewater treatment system. This schedule includes the rate for user charges as established herein and the rate for debt service charge, each based on the volume of metered water consumption unless otherwise noted.
