
On April 26, 2013, the Kentucky Public Service Commission issued an Order establishing a schedule for the above-captioned proceeding. Per the April 26 Order intervenor testimony is due on June 28, 2013. On June 5, 2013, Kentucky Power informed KIUC that it will not be able to provide a response to KIUC Data Request 1-53¹ until June 28, 2013. KIUC believes that the response to KIUC 1-53 could produce important information that may be crucial to a complete understanding of Kentucky Power's proposal. In order to have the opportunity to address Kentucky Power's response to KIUC 1-53 in its direct testimony, KIUC respectfully requests that the due date for intervenor testimony be extended by 1 week from June 28, 2013 to July 5, 2013. Counsel for Kentucky Power has agreed to support this change to the schedule.

¹ KIUC 1-53 requests that Kentucky Power provide the results of a recent 250 MW RFP that was conducted by Kentucky Power.
