1. For each county listed on pages 5 and 6 of Mr. Lanter's Direct Testimony,
  - a. Please provide a list of each assumption that was used by Mr. Lanter to estimate the number of "Customers in Poverty" in each county.
  - b. Please define all adjustments made by Mr. Lanter in his analysis to either the "Poverty Rate" or "Customers in Poverty" amount in each county.

**RESPONSE:**

- a. For each county in the table Mr. Lanter utilized the number of Columbia customers in the county (provided by the Company in response to data requests) and the poverty rate for that county as found in the American Community Survey (see response below to Question 2). The poverty rate percentage for each county was then applied to the number of Columbia customers residing in that county resulting in an estimate of the number of Columbia Gas customers living below the Federal Poverty Guideline in each county. The same formula was utilized for each county.

To determine the overall rate of poverty for the Columbia Gas service area (17.7 percent), Mr. Lanter totaled the estimated number of customers living in poverty (all counties) and divided that number into the total number of Columbia customers, multiplying the result by 100 to convert to a percentage.

This is a fair and accurate method for estimating the poverty rate among Columbia Gas customers in each county as there is no reason to believe the poverty rate among Columbia customers would be any different than the overall poverty rate of the communities in which they reside. It is worth pointing out again, that the Federal Poverty Guideline is an outdated and shameful undercalculation of poverty in America and the actual number of Columbia Gas customers unable to afford basic needs is likely much larger than the estimates presented here.

- b. No adjustments were made by Mr. Lanter in the reporting of Poverty Rate by county. For "Customers in Poverty" Mr. Lanter rounded each calculation to the nearest whole number.

2. Referring to page 5, lines 14-15, of Mr. Lanter's Direct Testimony, please provide a full copy of the data contained in the 2011 American Community Survey used to support the table presented at pages 5-6 of his Direct Testimony, and provide the website reference for reviewing county level data.

**RESPONSE:** See attached as Appendix 1, scanned hard copies printed from the Web site of the U.S. Census American Community Survey. County-level poverty data may be obtained on any county in Kentucky by visiting the following Web site and selecting the county from the dropdown menu: <http://quickfacts.census.gov/qfd/states/21000.html>

In collecting the response to this data request a typographical error was discovered regarding the poverty rate for Pike County. The correct rate, reflected in the chart below, is 22.2 percent. The change is a net reduction in the estimate of customers in poverty by 46 households. This reduces the overall estimated poverty rate for the Columbia Gas service area from 17.8 percent to 17.7 percent. This very minor difference has an insignificant impact on all other statements and assumptions in Mr. Lanter's testimony.

3. Please confirm that all households reflected in the American Community Survey that have income below the poverty level:
  - a. Do not pay natural gas bills directly.
  - b. Do not use natural gas for heating.
  - c. Cannot be considered poor based on household circumstances such as having status as a college student or a retiree who owns his own home.
  - d. Would not be considered under the poverty level when government transfers Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program or SNAP, Earned Income Credits, Medicaid, and other benefits) were added to the household income.

**RESPONSE:** The American Community Survey data is a measure of the number of households that fall below the Federal Poverty Guidelines outlined by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. These guidelines are a measure of income and do not consider any other household factors. The 2013 guidelines, currently available at this Web site - <http://aspe.hhs.gov/poverty/13poverty.cfm> - are below:

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- a. Overall poverty rates are relevant in this conversation as they likely reflect the poverty rates of Columbia Gas customers. We are not sure what is meant by “Do not pay natural gas bills directly.” Is the presumption that a household with low-income is unaffected if the natural gas bill is included in their rent? Such a presumption would require that

landlords and housing service providers not increase rents to account for such a cost which is highly unlikely.

- b. The American Community Survey does not track the number of households utilizing natural gas for heating. However, given the statistically significant sample size, the percentage of poverty in a county is likely to also reflect the percentage of Columbia Gas customers in the county living below the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- c. Poverty is a measure of income and not household status. A retiree who owns his or her own home is most likely on a fixed retirement income and thus less likely to afford an increase in natural gas rates. This is also true of college students, which include working parents trying to improve their situation by returning to school.
- d. Given the substantially low levels of income found in these guidelines it is unlikely that any “government transfers” change a household’s income to a level substantial enough to allow payment of an unaffordable utility bill. The benefits listed in this example include those such as Medicaid which are a service that does not increase a household’s income but merely assists with the most basic needs like food and health care.

4. *For each of the 13,012 energy assistance applications referenced at page 6, line of Mr. Lanter's Direct Testimony,*
- a. *Please provide the number of applications for natural gas service to be provided by Columbia, and the total dollar amount that was paid to Columbia for such utility service.*
  - b. *Please confirm that payments to Columbia were for both base rate charges and purchased gas charges.*

**RESPONSE:**

- a. Of the 13,012 energy assistance applications referenced on page 6, line 16 of Mr. Lanter's testimony, 2,207 were for natural gas service to be provided by Columbia. The total dollar amount that was paid to Columbia, \$296,849, is stated on page 6, line 18 of Mr. Lanter's testimony.
- b. Energy assistance provided by the Council does not differentiate between base rate charges, purchased gas charges, or any other charges but takes into account the total bill amount.



5. *Please confirm that the 21,124 households referenced on page 7, line 2 of Mr. Lanter's Direct Testimony are eligible for, and receive, benefits related to housing, food, and other needs.*

**RESPONSE:** It is not reasonable or possible to examine the individual situations of 21,124 households in response to this data request. Every household is unique and may or may not qualify for housing, food, child care, or many other types of assistance to help alleviate their inability to afford basic human needs. Because these households have incomes below basic survival needs it is likely most of them would qualify for some type of assistance, varying by household size, age of residents, type of residence, and a number of additional factors.

6. Please confirm that Columbia has offered energy assistance for up to 2,000 customers annually and that to date the program has not enrolled 2,000 natural gas customers.

**RESPONSE:** This response will presume the reference is to the Energy Assistance Program (EAP). The process for enrolling customers in the EAP prohibits full enrollment as a result of Columbia's information technology systems. The Council has made several attempts to address this challenge but the Company has not been able to make necessary adjustments.

To explain, the Council submits its final enrollment request on the 24<sup>th</sup> of each month but the Company does not process that enrollment for at least several days, often the end of each month. Meanwhile, the Company continues to remove customers from the program for shutoffs or other reasons. Therefore, by the time enrollment is processed it is already below the full availability of 2,000 slots. Thus, the program is unlikely to ever be fully enrolled without changes to that system. This is evidenced by the fact that actual enrollment is barely below the maximum number of slots at 2,000 (see chart below) despite this challenge.

Additionally, the Council was not notified by Columbia of the expansion of EAP from 1,500 slots to 2,000 slots until August 2012 and had to work to increase enrollment during a time when few people with low-income are seeking energy assistance (August, September, October). As the chart below demonstrates, the enrollment steadily increased over the course of the previous program year until it concluded just three (3) families short of full enrollment despite the challenge described above regarding enrollment processes.

7. Referring to page 6, lines 17-19, of Mr. Lanter's Direct Testimony, please explain how the amount of \$296,849 paid to Columbia helped "Columbia customers with low-incomes keep electricity coming into their homes." (Emphasis added).

**RESPONSE:** This is a typographical error and should read "...Columbia customers with low-incomes keep natural gas coming into their homes."

8. *What is the basis for Mr. Lanter's conclusion at page 8 lines 7-11, of his Direct Testimony that Columbia's proposed RNA Rider "waters down the role of the Kentucky Public Service Commission"?*

**RESPONSE:** It is the responsibility of the Kentucky Public Service Commission, taken from its own mission statement, "to foster the provision of safe and reliable service at a reasonable price to the customers of jurisdictional utilities while providing for the financial stability of those utilities by setting fair and just rates, and supporting their operational competence by overseeing regulated activities." The PSC has regulatory responsibility for matters affecting the price of utilities or other changes and any process which serves to reduce the frequency and extent of that regulatory activity does reduce the effectiveness and role of the Commission. It is simply not acceptable to place utility rates on autopilot for extended periods of time in the interest of convenience and cost reduction for any of the parties involved in the regulatory process. The RNA Rider is an attempt to fix a process that is not broken. If the utility at any time feels it is not receiving a fair, just and reasonable return then it has the right to file a rate case and attempt to recover such a return. If the utility is not recovering adequate return on its investment that has to be considered, at least in part, a failure by that utility to adequately forecast and seek rate relief for market trends (to the extent this affects the utility's solvency it is a public matter but to the extent it affects company profits that is not a public concern). It is not the fault of the regulatory process when a company fails to fully use that process to its own financial interest.

9. *Please provide all court decisions, regulatory orders, and theory-based treatises that support Mr. Lanter's conclusion at page 8, line 12, of his Direct Testimony that affordability is a factor in a regulatory body determining just and reasonable rates for a utility.*

**RESPONSE:** The Kentucky Revised Statutes covering the Public Service Commission, specifically KRS 278.030 (1) state that utilities “may demand, collect, and receive fair, just and reasonable rates for the services rendered...” Rates are not “reasonable” unless they are affordable. Further, KRS 278.190 states that “the burden of proof to show that the increased rate or charge is just and reasonable shall be on the utility, and the commission shall give to the hearing and decision of such questions preference over other questions pending before it...” Any reasonable person would conclude that affordability is a factor in whether or not a rate is reasonable and thus the intent of the Kentucky statute is that affordability be considered in determining fair, just and reasonable rates for a utility.

*10. Is it Mr. Lanter's belief that the sole purpose of rate regulation is to provide a utility such as Columbia with sufficient revenues to maintain its solvency? Please cite any statutory or legal principle that supports his belief.*

**RESPONSE:** It is not Mr. Lanter's belief that the sole purpose of rate regulation is to provide a utility such as Columbia with sufficient revenues to maintain its solvency. Additional purposes of rate regulation include determining whether the rates charged are fair, just, and reasonable (see response to Question 9 for statutory support). Mr. Lanter does not believe it is the role of the regulatory body to ensure adequate return to a utility's investors. As a monopoly the utility already has an advantage in that area and as long as the regulatory process is fair and just any well-managed utility should be able to ensure such returns. Mr. Lanter does not consider it fair that, in an economy where most other industries are forced to cut staff, benefits, facilities, and other critical infrastructure in order to remain solvent, utilities as regulated monopolies are insulated from some of those decisions (not all, obviously) by their ability to pass rising costs on to customers through the ratemaking process. The small businesses that purchase the utility's commodity, in this case natural gas, do not have that luxury and may only increase prices to a level their market will support. This makes the regulatory process that much more important and affordability such a key factor.

*11. Please provide the actual income levels used to determine poverty levels to support your assertion that 17.8% of CKYs customers are below the poverty level.*

**RESPONSE:** See the chart Federal Poverty Guidelines provided in response to Question 3.

*12. Please provide the table number or actual table from the American Community Survey, used to determine the poverty level by county.*

**RESPONSE:** See response to Question 2 above and attached Appendix 1.

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
