MOTION TO AMEND PETITION

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), by and through counsel, and moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission for an Order allowing it to amend its Petition filed on April 30, 2013, in order to clarify the timing of the requested approval of the Special Contract by the Commission.

In support of this Motion, EKPC states as follows:

1. The Petition was filed on April, 30, 2013, along with a companion Motion for Confidential Treatment of Information, requesting that the Commission approve the newly executed Special Contract setting forth the terms and conditions for the provision of electric service by EKPC and Owen Electric Cooperative to Gallatin Steel Company ("Gallatin Steel").
2. All of the allegations contained in the original Petition are adopted and restated by EKPC.
3. The cover letter accompanying the Petition for Approval and Motion for Confidential Treatment requested that the Commission rule on the Petition for Approval no later than May 15, 2013 in order for EKPC to participate in PJM's Base Residual Auction by bidding customers' interruptible load into the PJM Interconnection's Demand Response Program.
4. However, EKPC recognizes that the changes which are contained in the newly executed Agreement for Electric Service, which take into account EKPC's integration into PJM

on June 1, 2013, are significant and substantive and that the Commission will likely not be able to consider and analyze all of these changes and enter an Order of Approval by May 15, 2013.

5. EKPC wishes to clarify that the inability of the Commission to approve this Special Contract by May 15, 2013 as requested previously will not impair its ability to participate in PJM's Base Residual Auction scheduled for mid-May 2013 and that an approval by that deadline is no longer required.


6. EKPC respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order allowing it to amend the Petition to add the following averment:

"9. EKPC intends to participate in PJM's Base Residual Auction by bidding customers' (such as Gallatin Steel's) load into PJM Interconnection's Demand Response Program. While Commission approval of this Agreement is not a pre-condition for such participation, EKPC requests that the Commission rule on the Petition as soon as is practicable. EKPC further requests that the notice period contained in KRS 278.180 be shortened from thirty (30) days to not less than twenty (20) days, and that the Commission accept this Agreement for Electric Service effective as of June 1, 2013, which is the effective date set forth in the Agreement."

WHEREFORE, EKPC respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order allowing its Petition of April 30, 2013 to be amended consistent with that contained above.
