PETITION FOR REVIEW, APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF  
NUMBERING RESOURCES,  
AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

Windstream Norlight, Inc., (“Windstream”) petitions the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“Commission”) pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(4) to review and overturn a recent decision by the Pooling Administrator (“PA”) to withhold certain numbering resources from Windstream needed by the company to continue to provide reliable and adequate service to customers. In support of its Petition Windstream states:

Windstream’s Application And PA’s Denial

1. On April 5, 2013 Windstream filed a request with the PA for a single “thousands” block of numbers for LRNs for new Metaswitchs which will serve customers in Windstream’s Glasgow, Hopkinsville, Lexington and Richmond rate centers. A copy each of the Applications are attached as **EXHIBIT 1**.

2. The additional numbering resources are required to permit Windstream to upgrade the current switch platform to a new Metaswitch that will allow Windstream to provide next generation VoIP services to its end users. Once the new switch is established Windstream will migrate customers off of the existing Genband switch to the Metaswitch and decommission the Genband switch. In order to complete this transition seamless for its end users Windstream will

require two LRNs for each rate center in order to differentiate routing to the appropriate switch. According to the applicable industry *Location Routing Number (LRN) Assignment Practices document (ATIS-0300065)* Windstream must establish a unique LRN to identify the recipient switch or POI and must establish a LRN per LATA from an assigned NXX for the recipient switch in the number portability capable network. Thus, Windstream must obtain a LRN for this new packet switch. Also pursuant to industry guidelines, only a NXX code holder can obtain a LRN, thus necessitating Windstream's request for a NXX code, for these rate centers. (It should be noted, however, that Windstream would retain only a single thousand-number-block from the new NXX code.)

3. On April 5, 2013, the PA denied Windstream's request on the grounds that Windstream had not satisfied the months-to-exhaust ("MTE") criteria established in the Central Office Code Assignment Guidelines. A copy of each of the PA's denials are attached as **EXHIBIT 2**.

4. Windstream has demonstrated a verifiable need as Windstream will be unable to port numbers to the new Metaswitch or to provide new services using the Metaswitch.

5. Windstream can not satisfy the need for numbering resources from its current inventory or in any other manner and has exhausted all other available remedies.

#### Basis For Commission Review And Action

6. Under federal numbering rules, a state commission may overturn the PA's decision based on the determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for the numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies.<sup>1</sup>

7. In its Third Report and Order in the Number Resource Optimization proceeding, the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) found that “a carrier should be able to get additional number resources when there is verifiable need due to the carrier’s inability to satisfy a specific customer request.”<sup>2</sup> Thus, the Commission has the authority to overturn the PA’s decision in this matter.

8. As set forth above, Windstream has demonstrated a verifiable need due to deployment of a new switch and corresponding new service. In other cases, the Commission has granted the requested numbering relief despite the PA’s determination that the carrier did not meet the MTE or utilization thresholds.<sup>3</sup>

9. Granting Windstream’s Petition will not adversely affect the numbering resources available for use by carriers throughout the state in providing telecommunications services to their customers. Granting Windstream’s request is in the public interest and consistent with the FCC’s rules and decisions.

#### Request For Expedited Treatment

10. Windstream respectfully requests that the Commission act upon this Petition within ten business days. Expedited treatment is required to meet the needs of the persons to be served through the switch and Windstream’s internal business plans and schedule.

11. The FCC also has recognized the importance of timely action:

[W]e recognize that in many instances, the failure to address a request for additional numbering resources can impair a carrier's ability to stay in or expand business. We therefore direct states to act on carrier requests for a safety valve as expeditiously as possible. Although we do not establish a specific time limit for states to act on these requests, we believe that, in most instances, 10 business days from receipt of a request that the state determines to be sufficiently detailed and complete will be sufficient time to review and act upon safety valve requests.<sup>4</sup>

Therefore, Windstream respectfully requests that the Commission:

1. Overturn the Pooling Administrator's decision;
2. Direct the PA to grant Windstream's requests for numbering resources; and
3. Enter its Order doing so within ten business days, or as soon thereafter as is

possible; and

4. Grant Windstream such further relief as may be appropriate.

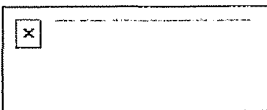

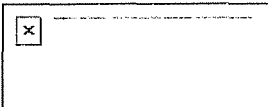
