

Due to a rate increase from the Kentucky River Authority, notice is hereby given that Jessamine County Water District No.1 has filed an application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its water rate. Customer rates will increase .10 cents per 1000 gallons used. The proposed change will be effective for service rendered on or after **July 15, 2013.**

The monthly bill of a customer using an average of 5000 gallons per month will increase \$.50 from \$32.25 to \$32.75 or +1.5%.

The rates contained in this notice are rates proposed by Jessamine Co. Water District No.1. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed fees. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than rates in this notice.

Any corporation, association, body politic, or person may by motion within thirty (30) days after publication of this notice request leave to intervene. Motion to intervene shall be submitted to the Kentucky Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40602. The motion must set forth the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.


Water Users

Dear Whom it May Concern:

The Kentucky River Authority, at its meeting of March 6, 2013, passed a resolution to increase Tier II water user fee to 13 cents per thousand gallons. The new rate will be effective July 1, 2013 and appear on fee billings issued August 1, 2013. This rate increase is necessary to finance reconstruction of the dams providing your water supply from the Kentucky River. Specifically this increase will finance reconstruction of Dam 8 at Jessamine County, renovate Lock 1 at Carrollton, renovate Lock 2 at Henry County and the Design of Dam 10 at Richmond. The Tier I fee will remain at the current level of 2.2 cents per thousand gallons.

Please take such actions as necessary, in preparation for the new level of fee assessments or call with any questions regarding this matter.
