It should be noted in the Informal Conference Memorandum dated February 6, 2014 that neither EKPC nor its counsel responded to the Complainants' question regarding why their request to move the easement made at EKPC's open house on November 10, 2005, which was similar to a request made by the Foleys, was denied while the Foleys' request was granted even though the new easement was going to have much greater impact on the Barkers' home and its occupants than on the Foleys. The adjustment to the easement has always been the primary request in the Barkers' negotiations with EKPC.
