



Finally, the Commission finds that the parties should include in their briefs an update on the status of any settlement negotiations that have taken place since the submission of EKPC's July 29, 2013 Offer of Settlement.

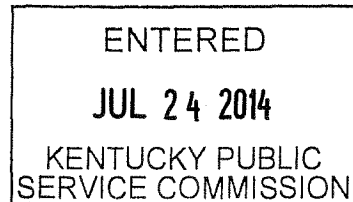
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Complainants and EKPC shall submit post-hearing briefs no later than August 15, 2014.

2. Post-hearing briefs shall include discussion, with supporting legal authority, on the possible range of remedies available to the Commission in adjudicating this matter, including the available remedies in the event a CPCN were to be required for the project.

3. Post-hearing briefs shall include a report on the status of any settlement negotiations held since July 29, 2013.
