TO SUBMIT THE CASE FOR DECISION ON THE RECORD

AmeriGas Partners, L.P. and AmeriGas Propane, L.P. (collectively "AmeriGas") hereby move the Public Service Commission ("Commission") to decide all of the issues presented in this case on the basis of the record as filed, including the letter to the Commission's Executive Director being filed contemporaneously herewith.

There are no other parties to this proceeding, and there are no remaining procedural items to address before the Commission may enter an order.
