I wish to express my opposition to the announced intentions of AmeriGas to discontinue the current gas service and replace it with individual residential tanks.

The following points should be considered:

To my knowledge there have been no complaints regarding our present system.

Individual residential tanks will not increase efficiency to us.

Some homes do not have room for individual tanks.

Our neighborhood has underground power lines. It is a beautiful golf course community with hills and many trees with lakeside access on the back of homes. We don't want the scenery to be marred by the tanks.

Our Old Bridge Neighborhood has restrictions regarding structures on property. The most important restriction states that personal tanks are not allowed on properties.

Even though I have all electric I do not want individual residential tanks.

We need to keep our property values up and allowing individual tanks will certainly devalue the subdivision.

We have had to abide by the restrictions. So AmeriGas should continue with this agreement.

This neighborhood should not be penalized with increasing gas prices for the benefit of the parent company.
