

Kenton County officials will meet with Latonia Lakes residents Friday night to discuss possible solutions to the community's deteriorating roads. The meeting will be at 7 p.m. at the lighthouse building of Oak Ridge Baptist Church, 6036 Clubhouse Drive.

Residents of the Latonia Lakes area, which has about 290 households, are looking for a way to repair and maintain their private roads that are sinking or crumbling and filled with potholes. Before residents voted to dissolve the city in November 2006, Kenton County officials told them the county was not legally required to take responsibility for Latonia Lakes' roads, and that they would have to be brought up to county subdivision standards for them to do so.

Unemployment rates fell in 55 Kentucky counties between February 2013 and February 2014, while 56 county rates went up and nine counties stayed the same, according to the state's Kentucky Office of Employment and Training.

Boone County recorded the lowest jobless rate in the state at 6.7 percent. It was followed by Oldham County, 7 percent; Fayette and Woodford counties, 7.1 percent each; Campbell, Kenton, Shelby, Warren and Webster counties, 7.3 percent each; and Simpson County, 7.4 percent.

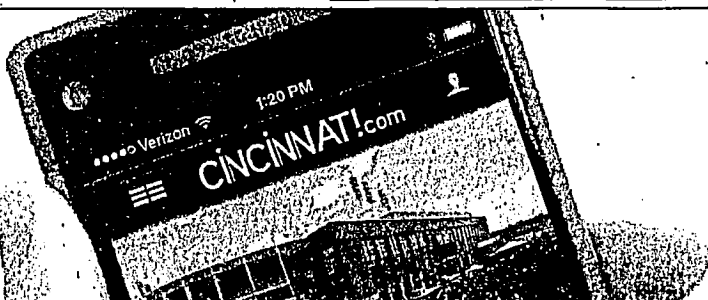


