Regarding the Provision of Sewer Service

Pursuant to the Commission's Order issued May 7, 2014, an informal conference was held in Case No. 2013-00470 on May 22, 2014. The informal conference was originally scheduled to start at 11:00 a.m. At the request of the utility, the time was changed to 2:45 p.m. A copy of the attendance roster is attached.

The informal conference was held at the request of the utility to see if the Commission required any further information. Mr. Smith stated that the utility obtained quotes only from Mr. Ron Eldridge for the tap on fees. Commission Staff requested that Mr. Eldridge provide a breakdown of the labor, material, and costs for the long side and short side installation. Commission staff also requested the utility obtain a quote from another vendor for comparison purposes.

Mr. Smith is not sure if the utility will amend the application to request the actual costs for some of the non-recurring charges. He is aware of notice requirements if the utility decides to amend the application and that an amendment could reset the statutory time period. Mr. Smith also understands that the Commission will issue a decision based on the record.

Mr. Smith requested three weeks to file the additional material and to determine if the utility will amend the application to request the higher actual costs. The three week period ends on June 12, 2014.

There being no further discussion, the conference was adjourned.
