COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO BIG RIVERS ELECTRIC CORPORATION

Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and ten copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due on or before August 13, 2014. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Big Rivers shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Big Rivers fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Big Rivers shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations.

1. Refer to the fifth sentence in the response to Item 1.e. of Commission Staff's Initial Request for Information ("Staff's First Request"), page 4 of 6. Outside of the advantage mentioned on lines 17-18 on this page, provide any additional advantages.

2. Refer to the attachment to the response to Item 3 of Staff's First Request, page 6 of 20.

a. Refer to the second sentence of the paragraph. Provide the reduction in margins that would result under the worse-case scenario.

b. Refer to the Margins column in Figure 2. State whether "Margins" refers to revenues less variable costs. If no, provide a definition for "Margins" as used in the table.

3. Refer to the response to Item 9 of the Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc.'s Initial Request for Information, Attachment 2, page 2 of 3, the second paragraph on the page. State whether Big Rivers currently has the type of rate

discussed in this paragraph. If no, state whether Big Rivers intends to request Commission approval for implementation of the rate. If yes, provide the case number and case style in which the rate was approved by the Commission.
