ORDER

On October 31, 2008, in Case No. 2008-00032,<sup>1</sup> the Commission approved rates for Burkesville Gas Company, Inc. ("Burkesville") and provided for their further adjustment on a monthly basis in accordance with Burkesville's Purchased Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA") clause. On June 1, 2013, Burkesville implemented a revision in its GCA clause to provide for quarterly adjustment of its rates.

On April 24, 2014, Burkesville filed an interim Gas Cost Recovery Rate ("GCR") application with a proposed effective date of May 27, 2014.

After reviewing the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Burkesville's notice includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in gas costs.
2. Burkesville's proposed EGC is \$9.3697 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.8412 per Mcf from the prior EGC of \$10.2109 per Mcf.
3. Burkesville's notice sets out no Refund Adjustment.
4. Burkesville's notice sets out its current Actual Cost Adjustment ("ACA") of \$.1985 per Mcf. Burkesville proposed a total ACA of \$.3484 per Mcf, which reflects a

previous ACA of \$.1880 per Mcf which should expire from Burkesville's rates May 31, 2014. Removing this expiring AA from the calculation produces a total ACA of \$.1604 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.1880 from its previous total ACA of \$.3484 per Mcf.

5. Burkesville's GCR is \$9.5301 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$1.0292 per Mcf from the previous GCR of \$10.5593 per Mcf.

6. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for service rendered by Burkesville on and after May 27, 2014.

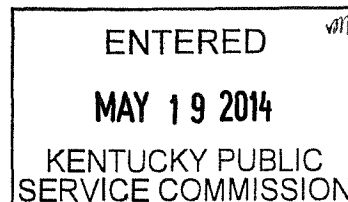
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Burkesville are denied.


2. The rates in the Appendix, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are approved for service rendered on and after May 27, 2014.
