ORDER

On August 13, 2014, the Commission issued an Order initiating this proceeding to review East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc.'s ("EKPC") fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") for the six-month period from November 1, 2013, through April 30, 2014. On August 25, 2014, Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Grayson") filed a motion for full intervention in this matter. Grayson's motion states that the matters addressed in this proceeding "bear a direct importance upon the terms and conditions of. . . [Grayson's] Wholesale Power Contract [with EKPC] and the owners/members of Grayson."

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, it appears to the Commission that Grayson purchases power from EKPC pursuant to rates, including FAC rates, set forth in tariffs on file with the Commission, and Grayson's intervention in this review of EKPC's FAC is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. The Commission finds that Grayson should

be granted full rights of a party in this proceeding. The Commission further finds that a procedural schedule should be established to process this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Grayson's motion to intervene is granted.
- 2. The procedural schedule set forth in the appendix, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed.
- 3. Grayson shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.
- 4. Should Grayson file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of these proceedings, Grayson shall serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
- 5. A person who submits a motion to intervene after September 19, 2014, and, upon a showing of good cause, is granted full intervention shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.
- 6. The Commission does not look favorably upon motions for continuance. Consequently, motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
- 7. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
