ORDER

Western Lewis-Rectorville Water & Gas District ("Western Lewis-Rectorville") filed an application for an adjustment in water rates pursuant to the alternative rate filing procedure for small utilities, 807 KAR 5:076. Western Lewis-Rectorville requests a deviation from 807 KAR 5:076, Section 9, that requires use of "a twelve (12) month historical test period, adjusted for known and measurable changes, that coincides with the reporting period of the applicant's annual report for the immediate past year."

Western Lewis-Rectorville states that when it began the process of completing the application, the 2012 annual report was the report for the immediate past year. Western Lewis-Rectorville states that it has taken a considerable amount of time to complete the application and that requiring a new application using the 2013 annual report, which is now the annual report for the immediate past year, will place an undue financial burden on the District.

Finding that Western Lewis-Rectorville has demonstrated good cause to permit its deviation from 807 KAR 5:076, Section 9, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Western Lewis-Rectorville's motion to deviate from 807 KAR 5:076, Section 9, is granted.

2. Nothing contained in this Order shall preclude the Commission from requiring the production of information regarding Western Lewis-Rectorville's financial condition or operations since December 31, 2012.
