#### ORDER

On September 8, 2014, Knox County Utility Commission ("Knox") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Knox purchases water from the Pineville Utility Commission ("Pineville"), the Barbourville Utility Commission, and the Corbin Utility Commission.
- 2. On August 1, 2014, Pineville increased its wholesale rate to Knox from \$2.77 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.96 per 1,000 gallons.<sup>2</sup> Knox proposed to increase the water rates to its customers effective October 1, 2014, to reflect the change in its cost of purchased water.
- 3. During the 12 months ended July 31, 2013, Knox purchased 11,207,000 gallons of water from Pineville and sold 131,692,000 gallons. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$2,129.33, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$0.02 per 1,000 gallons.

- 4. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.02 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
- 5. Knox's proposed rates, as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered on and after October 1, 2014.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment of \$0.02 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
- Knox's proposed rates are approved for water service rendered on and after October 1, 2014.
- 3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Knox shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
