ORDER

On October 27, 2014, Kenergy Corporation ("Kenergy") filed an application seeking authority for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to install an Advanced Metering Infrastructure system beginning in 2015 and continuing through 2016.

Having reviewed Kenergy's application, the Commission finds that an investigation will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed construction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed.
- 2. a. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed and shall include the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions related to the information provided, with copies to all parties and an original and seven copies to the Commission.

- b. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.
- c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.
- d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.
- 3. Any party filing testimony shall file an original and seven copies with the Commission, and a copy to all parties of record.
- 4. Kenergy shall give notice of a formal hearing in accordance with the provisions as set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b). At the time publication is requested, Kenergy shall file a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.
- 5. A person who submits a motion to intervene after December 8, 2014, and upon a showing of good cause is granted leave to intervene, shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.
- 6. At any public hearing in this matter, neither opening statements nor summarization of direct testimonies shall be permitted.

- 7. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.
- 8. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
