MOTIONS

Comes U.S. 60 Water District of Shelby and Franklin Counties, Kentucky, Inc. ("U.S. 60"), by counsel, and respectfully makes the following Motions:

1. U.S. 60 moves to increase the non-recurring charge for a 5/8 x 3/4 inch meter from the original \$1,000 to \$1,200. A new Average Meter Connection Expense Cost Justification worksheet is attached to this Motion. This represents an increase of 20% and is due to the increased costs of the radio read meters now being installed by U.S. 60 and the fact that U.S. 60 is charged a flat fee of \$135 for each trip for a dump truck and trailer, rather than mileage. The amounts for installation labor expense and installation equipment expense have decreased based upon the information from the work orders attached under Tab 14 to U.S. 60's Supplemental Answers to Commission Staff's First Request for Information. This requested amount has been rounded up from \$1,185.63 shown on the worksheet to \$1,200 based upon the fact that U.S. 60 knows the installation labor expenses will be more in the future because the employees did not know they were supposed to include on their work orders time spent at the office reviewing work orders and pulling the necessary materials prior to leaving for a job and the time spent at the office following the job completing the required paperwork, including the figures on the work orders.


2. U.S. 60 moves to change the requested non-recurring charge for a 1-inch meter from \$1,275 to actual cost. This request is based upon the fact that U.S. 60 did not set any 1-inch meters

during the test period reflected by the aforementioned work orders.

3. U.S. 60 moves the Commission to not require U.S. 60 to re-advertise these two revised non-recurring charge amounts based upon the additional cost which would be incurred by advertising in the four counties comprising U.S. 60's service territory. The previous advertisement in each of those four counties specifically stated that "The PSC may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates." The proposed 20% change in the 5/8 x 3/4 inch meter tap-on fee is not a sufficient change to require re-advertisement.

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
