ORDER


On June 13, 2014, U.S. 60 Water District of Shelby and Franklin Counties, Kentucky ("U.S. 60") notified the Commission that it is withdrawing its May 12, 2014 Motions. U.S. 60 moved on May 12, 2014, to increase the meter tap-on fees from the amount stated in its February 6, 2014 Application and for leave to not re-advertise the higher tap-on fees. The Commission will treat U.S. 60's June 13, 2014 Notice as a motion to remand its May 12, 2014 Motions.

Having considered the Motion to Remand, the Commission finds that it should be granted.

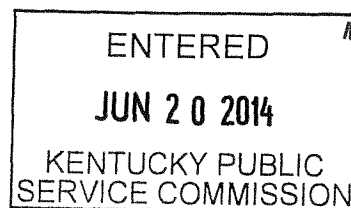
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
