ORDER

On October 31, 2008, in Case No. 2008-00032,¹ the Commission approved rates for Burkesville Gas Company, Inc. ("Burkesville") and provided for their further adjustment on a monthly basis in accordance with Burkesville's Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA") clause. On June 1, 2013, Burkesville implemented a revision in its GCA clause to provide for quarterly adjustment of its rates.²

On February 21, 2014, Burkesville filed its proposed GCA with a proposed effective date of March 26, 2014.

After reviewing the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Burkesville's notice includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in gas costs.
2. Burkesville's proposed EGC is \$10.2109 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.3179 per Mcf from the prior EGC of \$9.8930 per Mcf.
3. Burkesville's notice sets out no Refund Adjustment.

4. Burkesville's notice sets out a current Actual Adjustment ("AA") of \$.1985 per Mcf. Burkesville proposed a total AA of \$.3072 per Mcf, which incorrectly reflects an expired previous AA of (\$.0412) per Mcf. Burkesville's corrected \$.3484 per Mcf total AA represents an increase of \$.2397 per Mcf from the previous total AA of \$.1087 per Mcf.

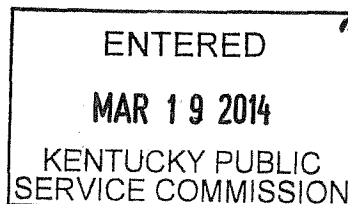
5. Burkesville's GCA is \$10.5593 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.5576 per Mcf from the previous GCA of \$10.0017 per Mcf.

6. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for service rendered by Burkesville on and after March 26, 2014.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Burkesville's proposed rates are denied.
2. The rates in the Appendix, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are approved for service rendered on and after March 26, 2014.
3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Burkesville shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.
