Pursuant to Commission Staff's May 22, 2014 Notice of Informal Conference, a telephonic Informal Conference ("IC") was held on May 27, 2014. Commission Staff requested the IC for the purpose of discussing issues in this matter. A list of the attendees is attached hereto.

Commission Staff began by noting that Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. ("Duke Energy") included in the calculations of its quarterly Rider PSM profit-sharing mechanism tariff filing, TFS 2014-00258, the losses resulting from the natural gas purchased but not used for its Woodsdale gas-fired plant that were sold in January and February 2014, and the treatment of which are at issue in the pending investigation in Case No. 2014-00078. Commission Staff asked Duke Energy why these costs were included in the tariff since they are at issue in the pending investigation. Duke Energy Staff responded that these amounts were included because they corresponded with revenue from PJM off-system sales.

After a brief discussion, Commission Staff and Duke Energy agreed that Duke Energy would amend its pending tariff filing to remove references to the natural gas losses in question in Case No. 2014-00078 before the tariff's effective date of June 2, 2014. Mr. Howard from the Attorney General's Office of Rate Intervention stated that the Attorney General's Office agreed with this solution.

There being no further discussions, the IC was adjourned.
