COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO GRAYSON RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION

Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Grayson"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and ten copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due within ten days from the date of this request. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Grayson shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though

correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Grayson fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Grayson shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations.

1. Refer to Grayson's response to Item 2.b. of Commission Staff's Initial Request for Information. The response states that 94 customers are currently taking service under Schedule 3.

a. Identify the customer classes to which the 94 customers will be transferred if Grayson's request to make Schedule 3 a rider is approved. Include in the response the number of customers that will be transferred to each customer class in such case.

b. For each customer that would be transferred to a class other than the Farm and Home class, state the class to which the customer would be transferred and provide the 2013 billing determinants for each of those customers.

2. For customers currently served under Schedule 3, state whether the electric thermal storage units ("ETS") are metered separately from the energy used for the rest of the premises.

3. If Grayson's request to make Schedule 3 a rider is approved, state whether the ETS unit will have to be separately metered. If the ETS unit will not have to be separately metered, explain how kWh usage for the ETS unit will be determined in order to be billed at the rider rate. If the ETS unit will be separately metered, state whether the customer will be charged for the meter installation. If the customer will be charged, provide the amount to be charged.
