When water usage is the basis for the utility's sewage treatment charge, the treated sewage adjustment shall be calculated as a per 1,000 gallon factor.

6. Treated sewage adjustment factor per 1,000 gallons*	.07 / 1000 Gals .05 / 100 CF
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\*The treated sewage adjustment factor is obtained by dividing the increased cost of the sewage treatment by the total gallons of water sold. (Number 5 ÷ ( Number 4 ÷ 1,000))

**Note:** The treated sewage adjustment factor is added to each thousand gallons sold. If the minimum usage is 2,000 gallons then the treated sewage adjustment factor would be added to the minimum bill twice.

**When the utility has a flat monthly rate the treated sewage adjustment factor shall be calculated as flat monthly amount to be added to the current rate.**


\*\*The treated sewage adjustment factor is obtained by dividing the increased cost by the number of customers and then by 12 months. (Number 5 ÷ ( Number 7 ÷ 12)).

## NOTICE

Lexington Fayette Urban County Government ("LFUCG") is providing notice that it has filed documents with the Public Service Commission to increase the sewage treatment fee it charges Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District effective for sewage treated on and after April 1, 2014. The proposed rate is as follows:

	<u>Current Rate</u>	<u>New Rate</u>	<u>\$ Change</u>	<u>% Change</u>
Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District	\$4.51 per 100 cubic feet	\$4.56 per 100 cubic feet	\$0.05 Increase	1.1% Increase

Sewage treated before the effective date will be charged at the current rate while sewage treated on and after the effective date will be charged at the new rate.

In accordance with Public Service Commission procedures, the effective date of the new rate cannot be prior to the expiration of a 30-day notice given to both the Commission and Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District

This filing may be examined at the offices of LFUCG located at 125 Lisle Industrial Avenue, Suite 180 in Lexington, Kentucky.

This filing may also be examined at the offices of the Public Service Commission located at 211 Sower Boulevard in Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday – Friday from 8:00 am – 4:30 pm or on the PSC website at <http://psc.ky.gov>.

Comments regarding this filing may be submitted by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort KY 40602; or through its website at <http://psc.ky.gov>.

The new rate is the rate proposed by LFUCG in its filing but the Public Service Commission may order a rate that differs from the proposed rate.

Intervention may be requested by submitting a timely written request for intervention by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the providing of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the filed application.
