In addition, areas of potential compliance problems for drinking water utilities, especially the Stage 2 Disinfection By-Product Rule, will be covered.

Speaker Bios:

Julie Roney has over 31 years of experience in the environmental field, with 24 years devoted to drinking water. She is currently the Drinking Water Program Coordinator for the KY Division of Water and has held various technical and supervisory positions with the DOW since February 1999. Prior to the DOW, she was employed by Kentucky-American Water Company beginning in September 1987, working in the Water Quality and Production Departments where she became their Water Quality Director. She began her career with Commonwealth Technology Incorporated in March 1980, progressing from a laboratory chemist to the Water and Microbiology Supervisor. Julie holds a Bachelor Degree in Biology from the University of Kentucky as well as a Class IVA Drinking Water Treatment license and Class IVD Drinking Water Distribution license.

Jackie Logsdon is an Environmental Scientist for the Kentucky Division of Water and provides technical assistance for utilities through the regional offices in Madisonville and Paducah. Jackie is a 1999 graduate of the University of Kentucky with a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology. He has been employed with the Division of Water since October, 2000.


