RE: Public meeting of May 14, 2014

A public meeting was held on May 14, 2014 in the above referenced case regarding the request of Lovelaceville Water Company ("Lovelaceville") to abandon its facilities. A list of public attendees is attached to this memorandum.

Andrew Melnykovych, Director of Communications for the Kentucky Public Service Commission, gave a presentation on the requirements and process for the abandonment of a regulated utility pursuant to KRS 278.021 and KRS 278.020(5). Mr. Melnykovych explained the typical reasons for abandonment, which may include financial difficulties. He presented an overview of the situation facing Lovelaceville, specifically discussing the utility's unstable financial condition and inability to secure customer meters. He further explained that the Public Service Commission would conduct an investigation into the requested abandonment, potentially hold a hearing, explore options to continue the utility's operation and ultimately issue an order adjudicating the request. Mr. Melnykovych noted that all avenues of continuing the water system's operation and viability would be explored, to include transfer to a new owner, forming a water association or establishing a water district.

Mr. Melnykovych answered numerous public questions and comments regarding a water association and explained that because a water association is a non-profit entity, it would potentially have access to grants and low-interest loans, for which Lovelaceville, as a for-profit entity, is not currently able to apply. He noted that access to such loans and grants would potentially aid in bolstering Lovelaceville's ailing system. Mr. Eric Young, Lovelaceville's owner/operator, also answered questions regarding the utility's condition and potential options for continuing service.

Finally, Mr. Melnykovych stated that as a last resort, the system would be shut down after customers had notice and a reasonable opportunity to make other arrangements for procuring a water source.
