

















There is no way the consumption could have been over 14,000 gallons of water. We would have had to fill up 15 swimming pools to have used that much water. We only have 2 people in our household.

Dear Layne Netherton,

Thank you for your contact. Our prior email communication indicated that we have scheduled a technician to visit your property to re-read the meter and to check for leaks between the dates of January 22, thru February 1st. Our technician will inspect the meter, obtain another reading and watch for meter movement. A physical visit is the second step of our high usage investigation. The first step is to direct our customer's to the leak detection information on our website and advise what types of things can cause the bill to escalate. You may contact us after February 2, 2014 and we will be happy to update you on the results of our visit.

Your email mentioned that you have verified that there are no leaks inside or outside of the property. Your historical usage indicates very erratic usage from month to month which can indicate the possibility of a malfunctioning toilet which is the most common type of leak that can easily go unnoticed. A dye test is a quick and easy method to check for toilet leaks. Put a few drops of food coloring in the holding tank of the toilet and don't flush. Wait for thirty minutes to an hour and see if any of the color seeps from the tank to the toilet bowl. If coloring appears in the bowl, the flapper is

likely allowing water to seep from the tank into the bowl which can cause a significant amount of water loss.
I have included a leak kit in the attachment to assist you in identifying any potential issues. Additional information may be found on our website at www.amwater.com. Hover over the heading title, "Learning Center" and click on the sub heading titled, "Wise Water Use".

I'm writing to you regarding two outstanding water bills we recently received.

11/6/13-12/5/13 \$836.79 for 145,860 gallons of water usage 12/6/13-01/7/14 \$607.40 for 103,972 gallons of water usage

These two bills, totaling \$1,444.19 are in addition to the LexServ bills totaling \$1,285.48 for the reported usage by KAWC.

There are two people that live in our home full-time and a daughter lives with us on a rotating basis every other weekend.

Since we moved into the home in May 2013, we our highest water bill was for \$102.64 for the time period 9/7/13-10/7/13. During that time period, we watered our lawn three times a week, which accounted for the unusually high bill.

With the exception of that one bill, our average monthly usage has been a little over 6,000-7,000 gallons per month, for an average bill of around \$70.00 per month.

We have had the meter re-read and also tested by KAWC. I am enclosing a copy of the meter test that was performed on 1/29/14. It indicates that the meter passed the performed test.

There is no leak at this time and we have not repaired any leaks in the past. The meter readings have returned to normal as of the last reading on 1/24/2014.

We are very conscientious regarding our home and our water usage so we are positive that we did not use this water. It doesn't make sense from any perspective that this amount of water could have possibly been used.

At this time we respectfully request that the Public Service Commission test the meter, review the matter, and grant a hearing if necessary.

I am also enclosing a recap of the water usage for our home since we moved in. We are requesting that someone can review this matter with a common sense perspective and recognize that there is a mistake in the usage reported and credit us accordingly.

We look forward to getting this matter resolved as soon as possible.







Response:

There is not a customer notification procedure associated with removing a water meter for testing when there is a variance or deviation in a customer's water usage that is noted on the daily billing edit and/or billing exception report. In the event of a variation, a service order is issued to verify the accuracy of the reading, and depending on the findings of that re-read, additional action may or may not need to occur. A meter may be removed from service if KAW believes that it is not functioning properly.

Residential meters are not tested in the field. If a customer requests the meter to be tested, since they are making the request, no notification of removal for testing is necessary. Customers are given the opportunity to witness the test which is performed at KAW facilities. Although residential customers are not explicitly notified of the removal following their request for testing, the meter change is noted on the ensuing billing statement. (See March 7, 2014 billing statement provided in Response to Item No. 1.)



The Complainants' invoice for the billing period of November 6, 2013, through December 5, 2013, was mailed to the customer on January 6, 2014. The invoice for the billing period of December 6, 2013 through January 7, 2014 was mailed to the customer on January 13, 2014.

- a. The invoice could not be issued until the meter reading was confirmed to be accurate. Therefore, the accuracy of the meter reading had to be confirmed by a KAW investigation. As part of that investigation, a service order was created on December 23, 2013, and the order was worked in the field on December 27, 2013. The meter reading on December 27, 2013 was 681, confirming that the December 5, 2013 meter reading of 545 was correct. The invoice for the November 6 to December 5 billing period was then issued January 6, 2014. Please also see KAW's response to Item No. 2 of Complainants' First Request for Information.






