ORDER

Bullitt Utilities, Inc. (“Bullitt Utilities”) has filed two motions for extensions of time to provide the information requested in our May 22, 2014 Order. Bullitt Utilities was to submit the requested information no later than June 5, 2014. On June 5, 2014, the utility initially requested an extension until June 9, 2014, to file the requested information. The utility failed to provide any support for its June 5, 2014 motion. The utility filed a second motion for extension of time on June 9, 2014, requesting it be allowed to file the requested information on June 16, 2014.

In support of its June 9, 2014 motion, the utility states that the information requested is extensive and located in two different locations. Bullitt Utilities does not have anyone working full time; therefore, additional time is necessary to locate and copy the requested material.

Having considered the two motions for extensions to provide the requested information, the Commission finds that the motions should be granted.

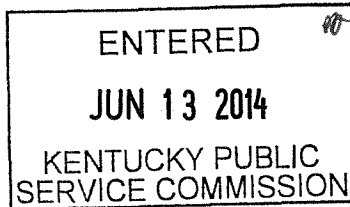
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
